

**Information disclaimer on the processing of personal data for Patients performing commercial laboratory tests at Mazowiecki Szpital Bródnowski Spółka z o.o.**

1. **The controller** of your personal data is Mazowiecki Szpital Bródnowski Spółka z o. o., 8 Kondratowicza St., 03-242 Warsaw, registered in the National Court Register kept by the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw, XIII Economic Department of the National Court Register under the KRS number 0000336164, having REGON 141983460, NIP 5242688913 hereinafter referred to as “Hospital” or “Administrator”. The Controller can be contacted by writing to the aforementioned address or by sending an e-mail to [sekretariat@brodnowski.pl](mailto:sekretariat@brodnowski.pl).

3. **your personal data is processed in order to:**

- providing you with health care services and managing health care services on the basis of Article 9(2)(h) of the GDPR,
- to fulfill the controller's legal obligations, including bookkeeping and tax settlements (pursuant to Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR),
- to enable the Hospital to defend its rights, establish or assert claims, which means that we process your data in order to realize our legitimate interest in accordance with Article 6(1)(f) GDPR,
- if you have expressed such a desire - to enable you to receive the results of laboratory tests online in accordance with the Regulations available in the registration and on the website of the service (Marcel S.A. eLaborat) on the basis of (Article 6.1.b GDPR).

4 **Recipients of your data are:**

- service providers of technical and organizational solutions that enable the provision of health services to you and the management of our Hospital,
- entities providing consulting services to the Controller, including legal services.
- MARCEL S.A. Laboratory Information Systems - as an entity providing a solution for receiving test results online.

5. The controller shall not transfer your personal data to a third country or international organization.

6. **period of storage of personal data:** data contained in medical records will be stored in accordance with the Act of November 6, 2008. on Patient's Rights and Ombudsman for Patient's Rights; data used for the purposes of accounting for health services, as well as data used to assert claims will be processed for the period of limitation of these claims in accordance with the provisions of the Civil Code; data processed for the purposes of accounting and tax settlements will be processed for a period of 5 years from the end of the calendar year in which the tax obligation arose; your e-mail address provided in order to receive the results online in the eLaborat system will be processed in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations available in the registration and on the website of the service (Marcel S.A. eLaborat) .

7 **You have the right to** access your personal data, the right to obtain a copy of your data, the right to rectify your personal data, the right to delete your data (the so-called “right to be forgotten”), the right to data portability, the right to restrict the processing of your personal data, the right to object to the processing of your personal data. The indicated requests may be submitted in any form, for accountability purposes, please submit them to the Administrator's address or to [sekretariat@brodnowski.pl](mailto:sekretariat@brodnowski.pl) or directly to the DPO [IOD@brodnowski.pl](mailto:IOD@brodnowski.pl). In case you believe that the Administrator's processing of your data violates the law, you have the right to file a complaint to the

supervisory authority, i.e. the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection (ePUAP sub-box of the Office for Personal Data Protection: /UODO/SkrytkaESP, [kancelaria@uodo.gov.pl](mailto:kancelaria@uodo.gov.pl))

**9. Providing personal data** is a necessary condition for providing health services due to legal requirements imposed on the Controller, including but not limited to the need to maintain medical records. Refusal to provide data may be the basis for refusal to provide health services. Providing data in the form of an e-mail address is necessary for you to receive the results online - if data is not provided, the results will be delivered by traditional mail. Provision of data is also necessary to issue a bill or invoice in the case of commercial services, failure to provide the necessary data may result, for example, in the inability to issue an invoice or bill.
