

**Information disclaimer regarding the processing of personal data at Mazowiecki Szpital Bródnowski  
Spółka z o.o. intended for Patients using commercial services.**

1. **The controller of** your personal data is Mazowiecki Szpital Bródnowski Spółka z o.o., 8 Kondratowicza St., 03-242 Warsaw, registered in the National Court Register kept by the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw, XIII Commercial Department of the National Court Register under KRS no. 0000336164, having REGON 141983460, NIP 5242688913 hereinafter referred to as "Hospital" or "Controller". The Controller can be contacted by writing to the above-mentioned address or by sending an e-mail to [sekretariat@brodnowski.pl](mailto:sekretariat@brodnowski.pl).

2. The Hospital has appointed a **DPO (Data Protection Officer)** - who can be contacted at: e-mail [IOD@brodnowski.pl](mailto:IOD@brodnowski.pl)

**3. your personal data is processed in order to:**

- providing you with health care services and managing health care services on the basis of Article 9(2)(h) of the GDPR,
- keeping accounting books and tax settlements on the basis of Article 6(1)(c) GDPR,
- execution of the concluded contract for the provision of commercial health care services on the basis of Article 6(1)(b) GDPR,
- defense of rights and assertion of claims by the Controller in connection with its activities on the basis of Article 6(1)(f) GDPR,
- to protect your vital interests (in particular, to save your health, life) on the basis of Article 9(2)(c) GDPR,
- for archival, scientific or statistical purposes - the legal basis of Article 9(2)(j) GDPR.

**4. Recipients of your data are:**

- service providers of technical and organizational solutions enabling the provision of your health services and management of our Hospital, including entities servicing/managing medical, diagnostic devices,
- entities providing consulting services to the Controller, including legal services,
- Your personal data may also be made available to entities authorized under generally applicable laws, in particular in accordance with Article 26 of the Act of November 6, 2008 on Patients' Rights and Patients' Rights Ombudsman

5. The controller as a rule transfers your personal data to a third country or an international organization, in emergency situations, i.e. in case of failure of medical apparatus, diagnostic devices, personal data may be transferred to a third country (to the United States, Switzerland, the United Kingdom) - by entities engaged in the repair or servicing of equipment. With the indicated entities, contracts have been concluded governing the entrustment of data processing, and the transfer of data is carried out based on standard contractual clauses.

**6. Period of storage of personal data:**

- data contained in medical records in accordance with the Act of November 6, 2008 on Patients' Rights and the Ombudsman for Patients' Rights will be stored for a period of 20 years, counting from the end of the calendar year in which the last entry was made, in the case of records relating to transfusion of blood and its components for a period of 30 years, in the case of death of a patient due to injury or poisoning for a period of 30 years, in the case of X-rays stored outside medical records for a period of 10 years.

- data for the purpose of billing for health services, as well as data for the purpose of asserting claims will be processed for the period of limitation of these claims in accordance with the provisions of the Civil Code.

- data processed for the purpose of implementing the concluded agreement and for accounting and tax settlement purposes will be processed for a period of 5 years from the end of the calendar year in which the tax obligation arose.

- Your personal data obtained in connection with video surveillance conducted on the premises of the Hospital, including your image, will be processed for a period of up to 3 months from the date of registration of your image.

7. **You have the right to** access your personal data, the right to obtain a copy of your data, the right to rectify your personal data, the right to delete your data (the so-called “right to be forgotten”), the right to data portability, the right to restrict the processing of your personal data, the right to object to the processing of your personal data. The indicated requests may be made in any form, for the sake of accountability we kindly ask you to make them to the Administrator's address or to [sekretariat@brodnowski.pl](mailto:sekretariat@brodnowski.pl) or directly to the DPO at [IOD@brodnowski.pl](mailto:IOD@brodnowski.pl).

8. In case you believe that the Administrator's processing of your data violates the law, you have the right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority, i.e. the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection (ePUAP sub-box of the Office for Personal Data Protection: /UODO/SkrytkaESP, [kancelaria@uodo.gov.pl](mailto:kancelaria@uodo.gov.pl))

9. **Providing personal data** is a necessary condition for providing health services due to legal requirements imposed on the Controller, including but not limited to the need to maintain medical records. Refusal to provide data may be the basis for refusal to provide health services. Provision of data is also necessary to conclude and execute a contract for the provision of commercial health services, to issue a bill or invoice, failure to provide the necessary data may result, for example, in the inability to conclude and execute the contract and issue an invoice or bill.

10. Automated decisions, including decisions based on profiling, will not be made in relation to you.
