

**Disclosure regarding the use of video surveillance on the premises
of Mazowiecki Szpital Bródnowski**

1. Mazowiecki Szpital Bródnowski Sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Warsaw (03-242) 8 Kondratowicza St., 03-242 Warsaw, registered in the National Court Register kept by the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw, XIII Economic Department of the National Court Register with KRS no. 0000336164, REGON 141983460, NIP 5242688913 hereinafter referred to as "Hospital" or "Controller" conducts 24-hour video monitoring on the premises of the Hospital, the monitoring is conducted in order to:

a. to increase the safety of the employed personnel and patients receiving health services provided to them, as well as to protect property from theft or destruction, to defend and assert claims - pursuant to Article 6 (1) (f) of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27, 2016. on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free flow of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/We (GDPR), monitoring, as a security measure, is carried out in the passageways of the Hospital's buildings, covering areas accessible to the public, i.e.: entrances/exits, registration, gatehouse, elevators, the area of the Emergency Room, the area of entry/exit to the Hospital's premises and hospital parking lots;

b. to ensure the safety of patients in the process of treatment in areas where health services are provided, e.g. observation rooms - in accordance with Article 23 of the Act of April 15, 2011 on Medical Activities.

2. areas covered by monitoring are marked with boards with a picture of a camera and the inscription "facility monitored around the clock". The controller of personal data processed in the monitoring system is Mazowiecki Szpital Bródnowski Sp. z o.o.

3. The recording from the cameras is stored on the servers of the Hospital for up to 3 months after the recording. After this period, it is automatically overwritten and the earlier data is permanently deleted, subject to the next sentence. In the event that the image recordings will constitute evidence in a proceeding conducted under generally applicable laws, or the Controller becomes aware that they may constitute evidence in the proceeding, the period specified in the preceding sentence shall be extended until the proceeding is legally concluded.

4. Access to data from the surveillance recordings shall be provided to authorized employees of the Hospital, security service personnel, entities with which the Hospital has entered into agreements, e.g. for servicing devices, and entities authorized to access data under applicable laws. The recording of events captured by surveillance cameras may be made available only upon written request, to entities authorized to do so under separate regulations.

5. Personal data from video surveillance will not be subjected to any form of automated processing, in particular profiling. They will not be transferred to a third country or international organization.

6. You have the right to access the content of this data, erasure or restriction of processing, portability, rectification, as well as the right to object to processing.

7. Compliance with the data protection rules at Mazowiecki Bródnowski Hospital, Ltd. is supervised by a designated DPO, who can be contacted via e-mail address: IOD@brodnowski.pl
